The staff of the St. Johns River Water Management District has completed their review of the environmental resource permit application(s) described below. Based on this review, the District gives notice of its decision for the application(s) described below. The District is providing you this notice because you are either listed as a County Interested Person or you expressed an interest in one or more of these application(s).

## The District gives notice of its decision to grant permit(s) for the following application(s):

Timothy S Wakefield, 241 Lansing Island Dr, Indian Harbour Beach, FL 32937-5102 application #16434-21. The project is located in Brevard County, Section: 3, Township: 27 South, Range: 37 East, and includes 1.01 acres. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for installation of new hip roof over new boat lift. The project is known as Wakefield Roof and Boat Lift. The receiving waterbody is Banana River Aquatic Preserve.

WCI Communities LLC, Ste 101B, 8895 N Military Trl, West Palm Bch, FL 33410-6259, application #145024-2. The project is located in Brevard County, Sections: 21, 27 and 28, Township: 26 South, Range: 36 East, and includes 147.0 acres. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for construction of a surface water management system to serve proposed residential single-family detached and duplex units. The project is known as Bridgewater North at Viera. The receiving waterbodies are Lake Winder, St. John River.

U.S. Air Force, 45th Space Wing, 1224 Jupiter St, Patrick AFB, FL 32925-3343, application #138129-2. The project is located in Brevard County, Section: 29, Township: 23 South, Range: 38 East, and includes 4.19 acres. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for construction of four buildings, paved/stabilized walkways, stabilized parking, and a stormwater management system for the project known as Cape Canaveral AFS Lighthouse. The receiving waterbody is Banana River.

McClain Vaughn & Partners Sonic Group, 425 Christine Dr, Ridgeland, MS 39157-3437 application #15955-17. The project is located in Brevard County, Section: 4, Township: 29 South, Range: 37 East, and includes 0.72 acres. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for a net increase of 147 sf to impervious to an existing sub-basin for the construction of a Sonic fast food restaurant on 0.72-acres at the existing Wal-Mart Supercenter. The project is known as Sonic at Wal-Mart Supercenter Malabar Rd. The receiving waterbody is Indian River Lagoon.

Orlando - Melbourne International Airport, Ste 220, 1 Air Terminal Pkwy, Melbourne, FL 32901-1865, application #16621-9. The project is located in Brevard County, Section: 32, Township: 27 South, Range: 37 East, and includes 8.52 acres. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for construction of a temporary bypass road and a construction staging area. A new surface water management system is proposed to serve the road. The project is known as Temporary Construction Lay-Down & Grumman Bypass - NG. The receiving waterbody is Indian River Lagoon.

The Environmental Resource Permit application includes relocating the western portion of the gravel maintenance road that runs parallel to Pearl Street to be immediately adjacent to the burial areas at the northwest corner of the property and eliminating the curve in the maintenance road north of SMF No. 2. The project is known as US Dept. of Veterans Affairs Cape Canaveral National Cemetery, Phase 1, Scottsmoor, Florida. The receiving waterbody is Indian River Lagoon.
