Dear Sir/Madam:

This is your notification that the St. Johns River Water Management District (District) has received the Individual Consumptive Use Permit (CUP) application(s) listed below:

Walkers Green Development, LLC, 794 Sanders Rd Ste C, Port Orange, FL 32127-4229, Consumptive Use Permit application #183889-1, received April 11, 2022. The applicant proposes to withdraw 7.896 mgd for dewatering to mine a 48.99-acre borrow pit. The withdrawals used by this proposed project will consist of Surface Water from Settlement Basin via 3 proposed pumps; in Volusia County, located in Sections 1 and 2, Township 16 South, Range 32 East. This project is known as Walkers Green Borrow Pit.

MW & Sons Farms LLC, 2220 McBride Rd, Seville, FL 32190-7860, Consumptive Use Permit application #9295-7, received April 21, 2022. The applicant proposes the use of 0.020 million gallons per day of groundwater from the Upper Floridan aquifer (UFA) for irrigation of 7.12 acres of cut foliage and maximum daily withdrawals of 0.867 mgd of groundwater from the UFA for crop (freeze) protection. The withdrawals used by this existing project will consist of Groundwater from FAS - Upper Floridan Aquifer via 1 active well in Volusia County, located in Section 31, Township 13 South, Range 28 East. This project is known as Baylor.

The file(s) containing the permit application(s) are available at www.sjrwmd.com/permitting and then click on "Regulatory Permit Search".

The District issues two types of Individual consumptive use permits (CUPs) – staff-issued CUPs and Governing Board-issued CUPs. Decisions on Individual CUP application(s) will be made at either a District service center (if staff-issued) or at the District's Governing Board meeting where permit applications that have not been delegated to District staff will be acted upon. The Governing Board normally meets on the second Tuesday of the month.

Objections, comments, questions, or information regarding an application for an Individual CUP must be made in writing and received by the Director, Office of Business and Administrative Services, P.O. Box 1429, Palatka, FL 32178-1429, or by e-mail at applicationsupport@sjrwmd.com as soon as possible after the notification of the application receipt. The Permit Application Number or the Project Name should be included in the objection. If the District receives a timely objection, the objector will receive written notice of the District's decision (or intended decision) on the permit application.

A Notice of Decision (or Notice of Intended District Decision) will be provided to persons who timely requested individual notice. A request for individual notice must be received by the Director, Office of Business and Administrative Services, prior to the date the Notice of Decision (or Notice of Intended District Decision) is generated. Please note that filing a written objection does not entitle you to a Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, administrative hearing. For more information, call (386) 329-4570.
