The District gives notice of its decision to grant permit(s) for the following application(s):

Park Square Enterprises, LLC, 5200 Vineland Rd, Ste 200, Orlando, FL 32811-7674 application #175126-1. The project is located in Orange County, Section 4, Township 22 South, Range 28 East. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for construction and operation of a Stormwater Management System for an 18.59-acre project known as the Reserve at Lake Meadow. The receiving waterbody is Lake Meadow.

The Environmental Resource Permit application is for the use of the General Permit for 62-330.451 for the installation of an exfiltration ditch to prevent erosion and provide additional treatment to be constructed. The receiving waterbody is unnamed wetlands.
