## The District gives notice of its decision to grant permit(s) for the following application(s):

Harris Groves, 5335 8th St, Vero Beach, FL 32968-1006 Consumptive Use Permit #2226-4. The District authorizes the use of 0.0001 million gallons per day (mgd) of groundwater from the Upper Floridan aquifer for livestock watering through 2044. The withdrawals used by this project will consist of Groundwater from FAS - Upper Floridan Aquifer via 1 active well in Indian River County, located in Section 7, Township 32 South, Range 39 East. This project is known as Harris #4.
