The Berry Company, LLC, 272 W Coleman Blvd, Ste 200, Mt Pleasant, SC 29464-5652 application #148749-32. The project is located in Brevard County, Sections 27 and 34, Township 26 South, Range 36 East. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for Construction and operation of a Stormwater Management System for a 19.01-acre project known as Restore at Viera Multi-family development. The receiving waterbody is Saint Johns River.
