The District gives notice of its decision to grant permit(s) for the following application(s):

Marjorie Thomas, 2211 Lee Rd, Ste 107, Winter Park, FL 32789-1849 Consumptive Use Permit #3340-7. The District Authorizes the use of 0.014 million gallons per day (mgd), annual average of groundwater for irrigation of 35 acres of pasture and the watering needs of livestock through 2035. The withdrawals used by this project will consist of Groundwater from FAS - Upper Floridan Aquifer via 3 active wells in Orange County, located in Sections 18 and 19, Township 20 South, Range 27 East. This project is known as Marjorie Thomas.

Weingarten Nostat, Inc., 2720 E. Colonial Dr., Orlando, FL 32803-5025 Consumptive Use Permit #7368-7. By letter modification, the District updated the permit conditions and permitted allocation in accordance with Section 1.2 of the CFWI Supplemental Applicant's Handbook. The District authorizes the use of 0.004 million gallons per day (mgd), annual average of groundwater from the Upper Floridan aquifer for irrigation of two acres of landscape through 2040. The withdrawals used by this project will consist of groundwater from the Upper Floridan aquifer via one active well in Orange County, located in Section 30, Township 22 South, Range 30 East for a project known as Colonial Plaza Shopping Center.
