Dear Sir/Madam:

This is your notification that the St. Johns River Water Management District (District) has received the Individual Consumptive Use Permit (CUP) application(s) listed below:

University of North Florida, 1 UNF Dr, Jacksonville, FL 32224-7699 Consumptive Use Permit application #551-17, received May 19, 2025. The applicant proposes the use of 0.137 million gallons per day (mgd) of surface water from the stormwater management system for landscape and recreation area irrigation, 0.008 mgd of groundwater from the Upper Floridan aquifer for landscape irrigation, and 0.021 mgd of groundwater from the Upper Floridan aquifer for emergency backup landscape and golf course irrigation. The withdrawals used by this project will consist of reclaimed water from JEA - South Grid via 4 active connection points and 2 proposed connection points; surface water from SWMF Ponds Nos. 2 and 3 via 1 active pump; surface water from Reclaimed Water Holding Tank via 1 active pump and 2 proposed pumps; surface water from 9A Stormwater ponds via 1 active pump; surface water from Lake No. 5 via 2 active pumps; Groundwater from FAS - Upper Floridan Aquifer via 2 active wells; reclaimed water from JEA via 1 proposed connection point and 11 active connection points; surface water from SWMF Pond No. 1 via 1 active pump; surface water from Reclaimed Water / Stormwater pond via 2 active pumps in Duval County, located in Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9, Township 3 South, Range 28 East; Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 28 East. This project is known as University of North Florida.

The file(s) containing the permit application(s) are available at www.sjrwmd.com/permitting and then click on "Regulatory Permit Search".

The District issues two types of Individual consumptive use permits (CUPs) – staff-issued CUPs and Governing Board-issued CUPs. Decisions on Individual CUP application(s) will be made at either a District service center (if staff-issued) or at the District's Governing Board meeting where permit applications that have not been delegated to District staff will be acted upon. The Governing Board normally meets on the second Tuesday of the month.

Objections, comments, questions, or information regarding an application for an Individual CUP must be made in writing and received by the Director, Office of Business and Administrative Services, P.O. Box 1429, Palatka, FL 32178-1429, or by e-mail at applicationsupport@sjrwmd.com as soon as possible after the notification of the application receipt. The Permit Application Number or the Project Name should be included in the objection. If the District receives a timely objection, the objector will receive written notice of the District's decision (or intended decision) on the permit application.

A Notice of Decision (or Notice of Intended District Decision) will be provided to persons who timely requested individual notice. A request for individual notice must be received by the Director, Office of Business and Administrative Services, prior to the date the Notice of Decision (or Notice of Intended District Decision) is generated. Please note that filing a written objection does not entitle you to a Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, administrative hearing. For more information, call (386) 329-4570.
