City of Winter Springs, 400 Old Sanford Oviedo Rd, Winter Springs, FL 32708-2617 application #148395-4. The project is located in Seminole County, Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 31 East. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for Modification of Permit IND-117-148395-1 for Tuskawilla Crossings to include the construction and operation of a 6.92-acre project known as Tuskawilla Crossings Subdivision Pond 1 Repair and Rehabilitation. The receiving waterbody is Lake Jesup and Tract B-1 Conservation Area.

FLA Conference Assn of Seventh-Day Adventists, 500 Education Loop, Apopka, FL 32703-6176 application #22348-25. The project is located in Seminole County, Section 8, Township 21 South, Range 29 East. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for Modification of Permit No. 22348-9 for the construction and operation of a Stormwater Management System for a 2.94-acre project known as Forest Lake Academy Expansion. The receiving waterbody is Mirror Lake.

First Baptist Church of Sweetwater, Inc., 3800 Wekiva Springs Rd, Longwood, FL 32779-3361 application #29254-2. The project is located in Seminole County, Sections 31 and 32, Township 20 South, Range 29 East. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for a letter modification of Permit No. 40-117-29254-1 for First Baptist Church of Sweetwater to include the construction of a 0. 0.14-acre project known as First Baptist Church of Sweetwater: handicapped parking. The receiving waterbody is Wekiva River.
