The Environmental Resource Permit application is for construction of a surface water management system to serve a multi-family residential development known as Beach Marine Phase 1. The receiving waterbody is Intracoastal Waterway.

Century Lake Townhomes LLC, 7563 Philips Hwy Ste 190, Jacksonville, FL 32256-6842 application #148326-1.
