Based on this review, the District gives notice of its decision for the application(s) described below. The District is providing you this notice because you are either listed as a County Interested Person or you expressed an interest in one or more of these application(s).

The District gives notice of its decision to grant permit(s) for the following application(s):

Semanik Equity Development & Acquisition Inc., Ste 3, 2120 Corporate Square Blvd, Jacksonville, FL 32216-1976 application #89376-7. The project is located in Nassau County, Section: 42, Township: 2 North, Range: 27 East, and includes 43.39 acres. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for a modification of Permit #89376-6 by combining SWMF 8 and 9 into a single wet detention pond SWMF-9, the enlargement of wet detention pond SWMF-10 and additional mitigation for secondary impacts. The project is known as Hideaway Phase 1B and 1C. The receiving waterbody is Gardner Creek.

Harbor Shores Apostolic Church, 86189 Augustus Ave, Yulee, FL 32097-3881 application #148632-2. The project is located in Nassau County, Section: 51, Township: 3 North, Range: 27 East, and includes 5.0 acres. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for construction of a stormwater management system to serve a project known as Harbor Shores Apostolic Church.

The Commercial Range at Amelia, LLC, 4001 Centurion Way, Fernandina, FL 32034-5202 application #147305-2. The project is located in Nassau County, Section: 51, Township: 3 North, Range: 27 East; Section: 37, Township: 2 North, Range: 27 East, and includes 1.88 acres. The Environmental Resource Permit application is for construction of a stormwater management system to serve an extension of a two lane road with curb and gutter by 965 linear feet. The project is known as Nassau County Public Works Maintenance Facility - Phase 2. The receiving waterbody is Lofton Creek.
